- Needs to keep head up when engaged
- Top heavy body
- Still learning to play position

Andrew Billings is the best pure nose tackle prospect to come out of college in quite some time. He's got a short, stocky build that packs and immense punch. He's incredibly strong and dominates opponents with brute force. He hits with violent contact and has an explosive first step. He's also got an impressive long speed, but only in one direction. Billings is a phone booth player who excels in clogging lanes and collapsing the pocket. He can't turn and run or change direction quickly but he won't be asked to do that when pressing the pocket from a nose tackle position. Billings has the raw power, but not technique at the moment. He's young (just turned 21) and needs to mature his game before he will be truly dominant. That aside Billings is an immediate starter in the NFL and will be the bane of rushing attacks for years to come.
