- Strong blocker when engaged

Cons:

- Not known as a deep threat
- Inconsistent effort
- Not an overly aware player
- Doesn't play through whistle
- More interested in highlight plays than nitty gritty

Laquon Treadwell's biggest problem isn't his lack of speed. It's his lack of consistency. Treadwell likes to make flashy plays and doesn't play with consistency or all-out effort. That's not to say he's a bad teammate or he takes tons of play off, he just doesn't do the little things like follow through on a block or going after the corner who intercepts a pass. Besides that he's a great talent who will be a high draft pick this year. He's explosive and shows great route running skills. He has more elusiveness and speed than he's given credit for as well. He'll be a great outside receiver for whatever team drafts him. With his size, leaping ability and hands, he's going to be a quarterback's favorite target in a few years.
