Pros:

- Compact, tough corner
- Quick feet and loose hips
- Good shadowing technique
- Explosive player, great acceleration
- Competitive and gritty
- Short area quickness to stay with anyone
- Good use of hands and feet at line

Cons:

- Not a good tackler
- Small hands
- Shies away from contact
- Deep speed is average
- Bigger receivers can bully him at times
- Misused as a zone corner
- Plant and drive is a step late

Hargreaves was a bit miscast in the Florida defense last year. He was primarily deployed as a zone corner, playing in the flat and deep quarter. He is a much better press man corner who shadows receivers. He possesses great quickness and agility and isn't fooled by route fakes. Hargreaves isn't the physical presence that you would like at corner, but he's explosive and had a great vertical leap. His instincts when the ball is in the air are top notch as well. On the flip side he's got short arms and small hands. He also only has average deep speed to stay with receivers. The NFL is desperate for corners so Hargreaves will be a high draft pick on day one but he's not a classic shut down corner. Very good potential and has the earmarks of having an early start to his career, but might not be able to match up with every receiver as you'd expect with a top 10 corner.
